I am with CMA CGM since the 2006, when I have chosen to turn to the merchant vessels. Growing the experience year by year from Able Seaman, to Deck Officer and currently as Chief Officer at the moment, during these years I had the opportunity to learn from almost any rank onboard a merchant vessel may work-trade secrets.

Working with CMA CGM allowed me to work on vessels with different sizes, from 5.700 TEUs (Twenty-Equivalent Unit) and 277m in length up to 21.000 TEUs and 400m in length and with different technologies and, usually latest navigation equipment.

For about three years I had participated in Maritime Human Resource Department in the Head Office of the Company, gaining experience in this particular and many times invisible part of a seaman.

During part of the time I had the opportunity to be implicated in the development and implementation of the software the Company is currently using in the management of the vessels and the crews.

Seeing both parts of a seaman life, the on sea and the offshore allowed me to better understand the entanglement, and the way I could contribute and to communicate with and to the Office and to the Crews.
